Hammaren Memorial Foundation and Arts Institute was inspired following Caitlin's senseless death on the morning of April 16th, 2007, while she attended her French class at Virginia Tech. She was 19 years old, an only child, completing her sophomore year. Caitlin was pursuing a double major in International Studies and Leadership, with a minor in French.

Caitlin was well known for her smile, warm personality and nurturing disposition. All those touched by Caitlin were left with a lasting impression of her kindness. She frequently engaged in little acts of kindness, under the radar, quietly and unobtrusively assisting or comforting those around her whom she intuitively sensed were in need.

Caitlin loved the Arts and was involved in many aspects of them. She participated in the fine arts, singing, playing violin, theater, dressage and the culinary arts. Caitlin lived each day to the fullest. A close friend described Caitlin as mastering the "Art of Living."

The Caitlin M. Hammaren Memorial Foundation and Arts Institute will continue those quiet "little acts of kindness" to assist others and keep alive the essence that is "Caitlin" through their own passion for the Arts.
